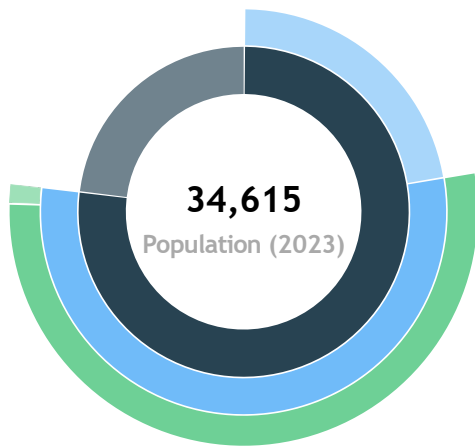
Median household income is \$4.1K above the national median household income of \$69.0K.

Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 1.4% since 2017, growing by 464. Population is expected to increase by 3.1% between 2022 and 2027, adding 1,055.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 3.3% in Putnam County, OH from 13,117 to 13,548. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 0.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 70.9% to 70.8% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, 32.2% of Putnam County, OH residents possess a college degree of associate degree or higher.
- The top industries in 2022 are Motor Vehicle Manufacturing, Education and Local Government, and Restaurants/Other Eating Places.

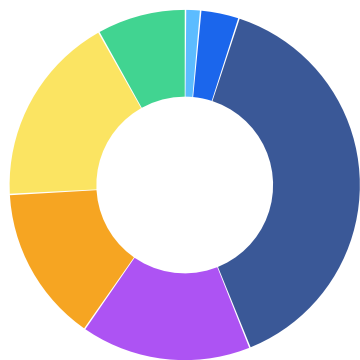

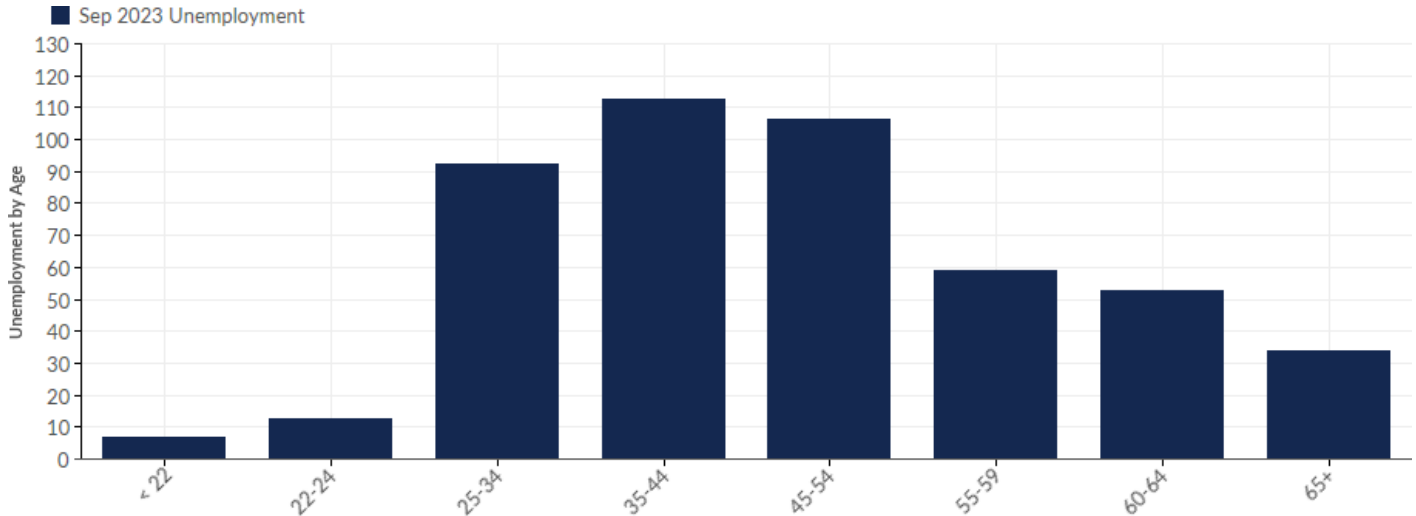

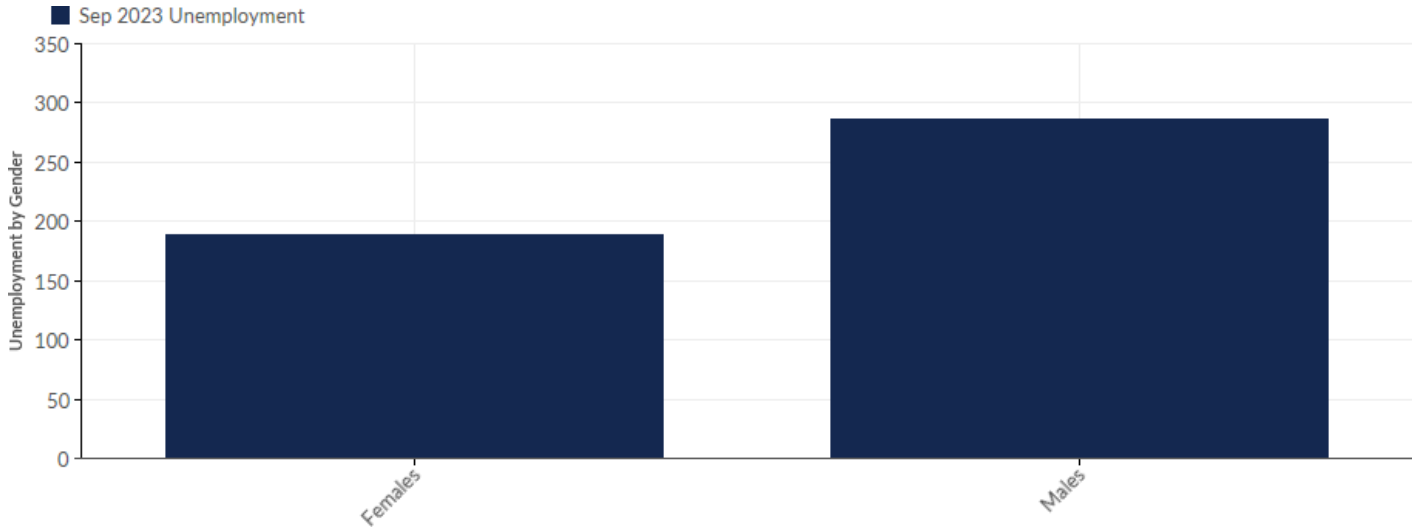

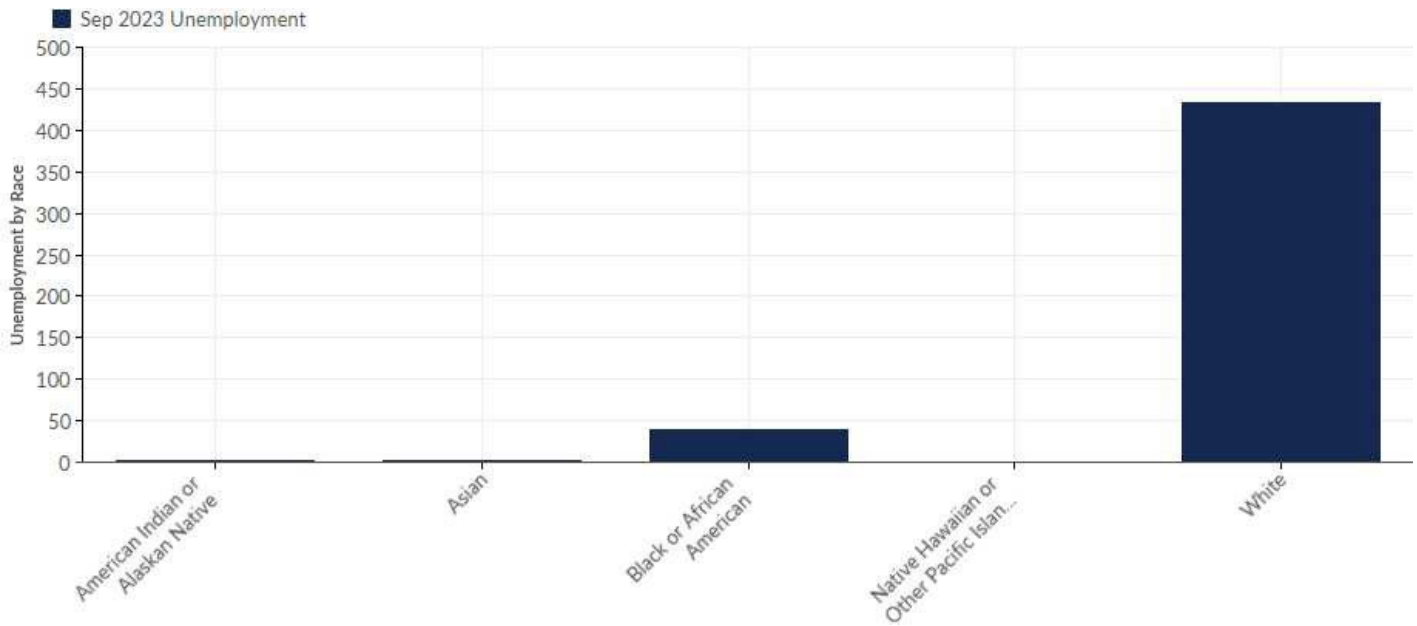
Unemployment by Gender

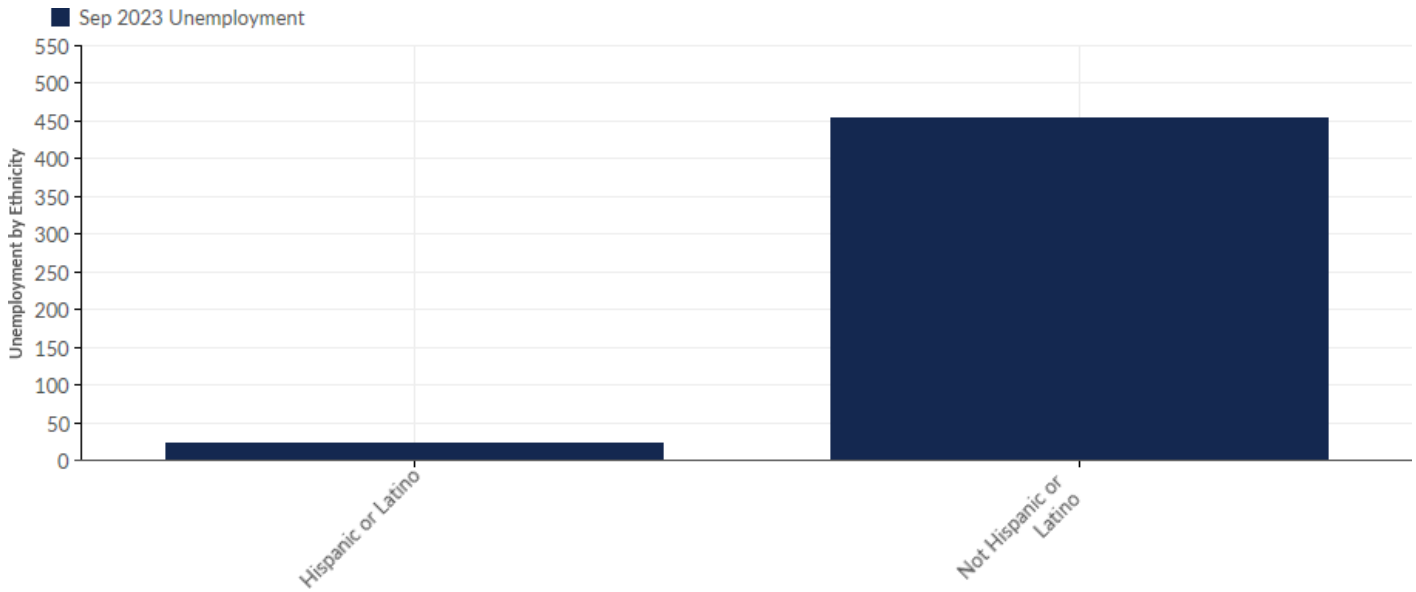

Unemployment by Ethnicity



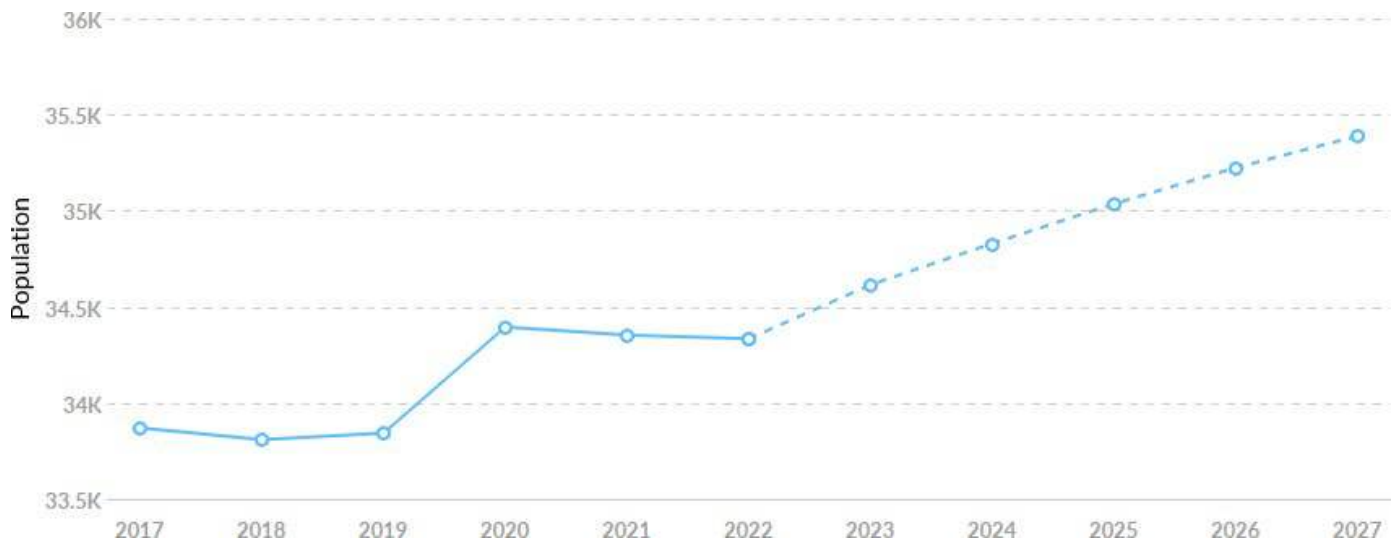

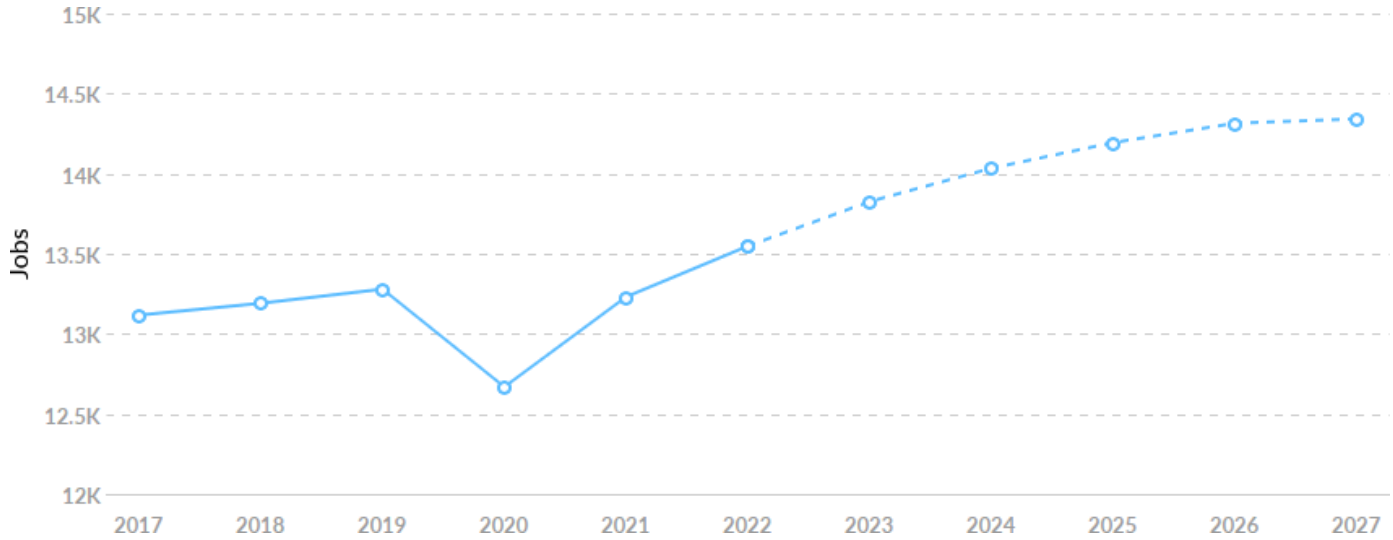

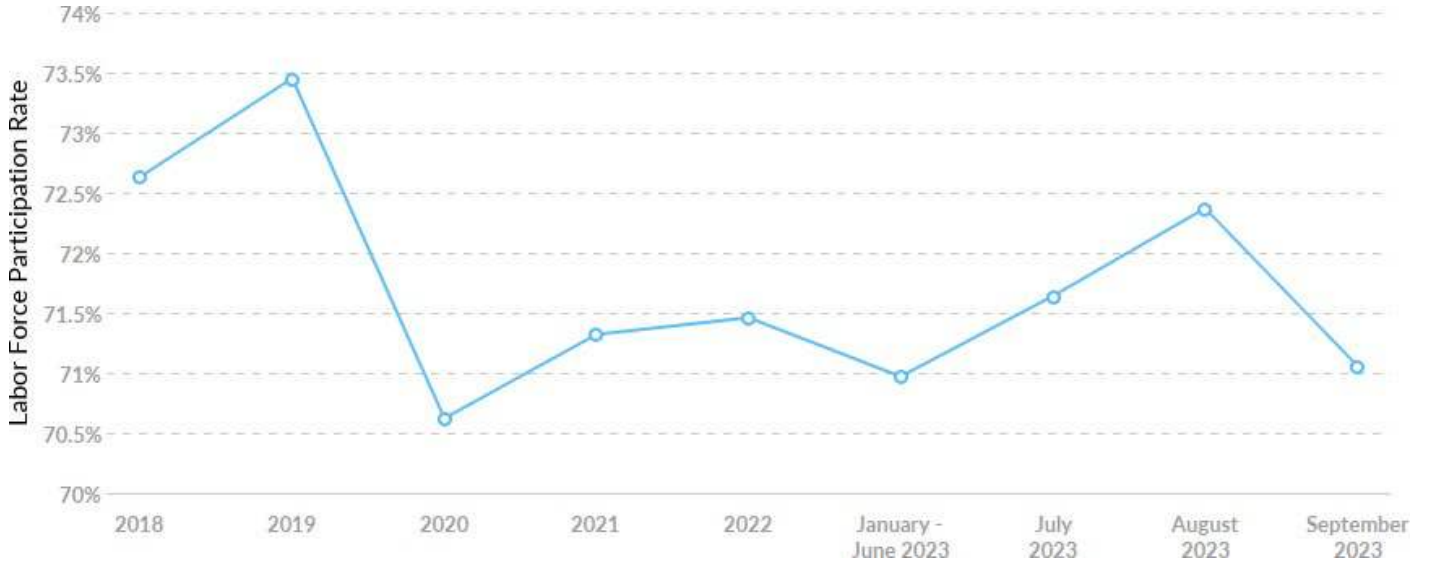

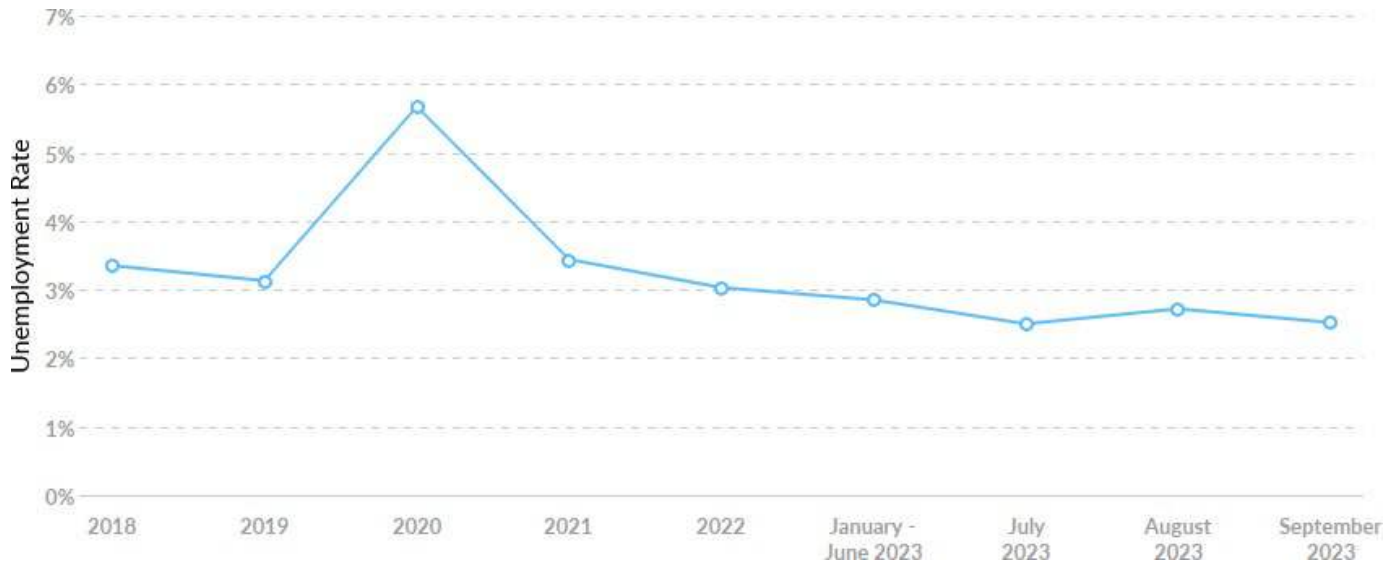

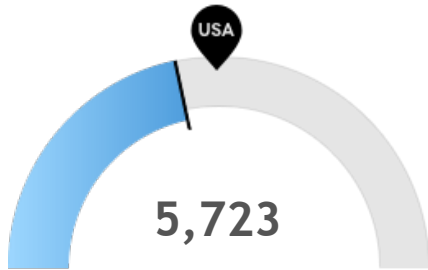
Unemployment Rate Trends

Putnam County, OH had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 2.52%, decreasing from 3.35% 5 years before.



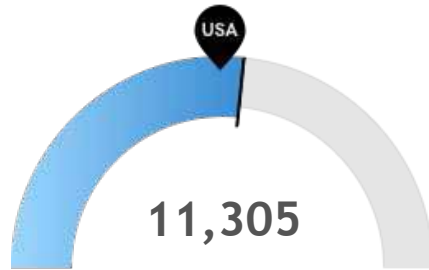

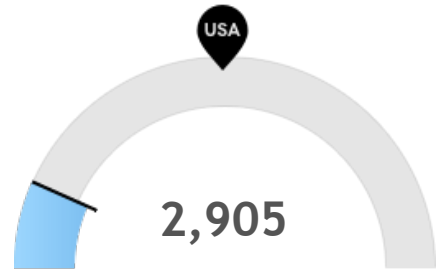
Millennials

Putnam County, OH has 5,723 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 6,981.



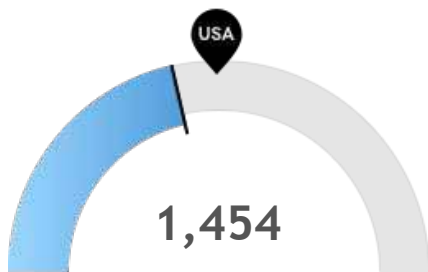
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Putnam County, OH. The national average for an area this size is 10,289 people 55 or older.



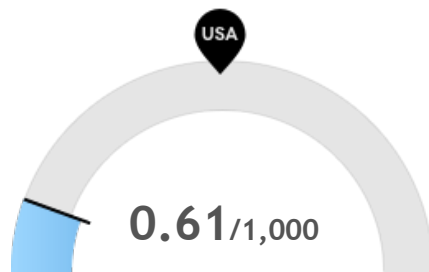
Racial Diversity

The national average for racial diversity an area this size is 14,120 racially diverse people, while there are 2,905 here.



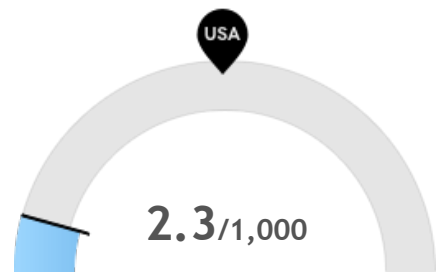
Veterans

Putnam County, OH has 0.61 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.



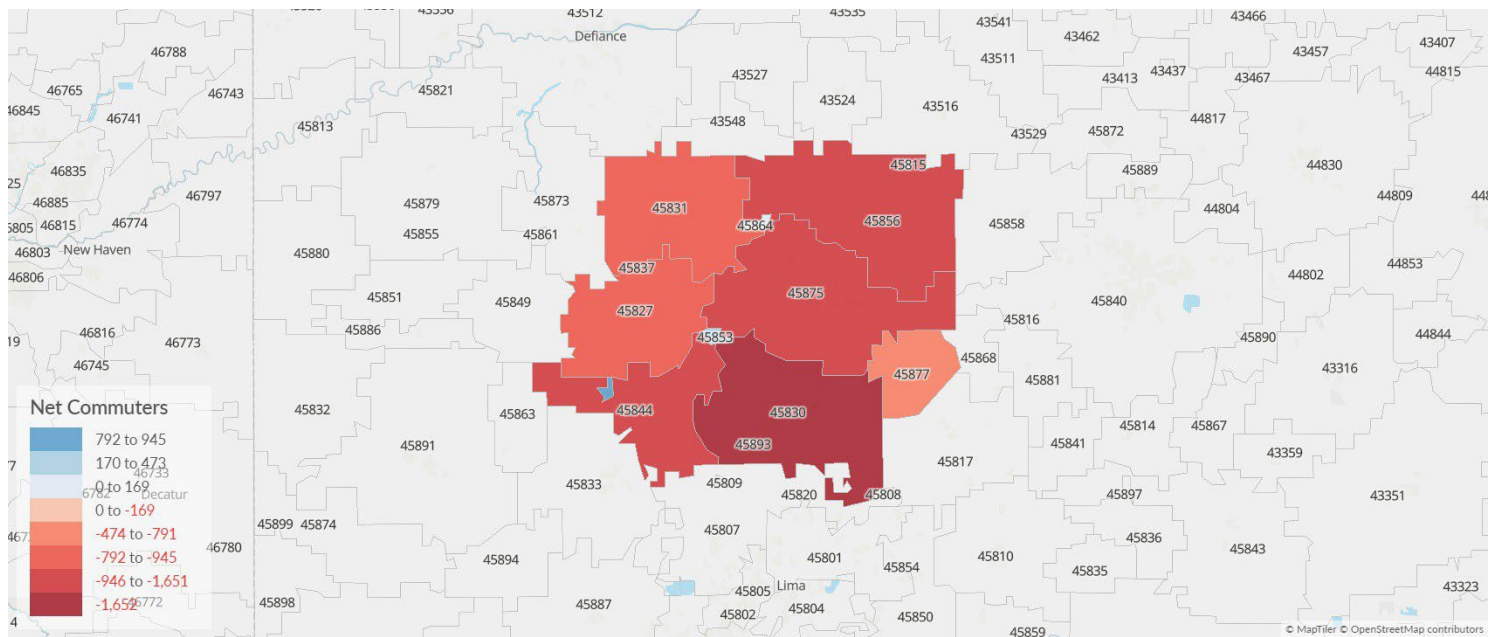
Property Crime

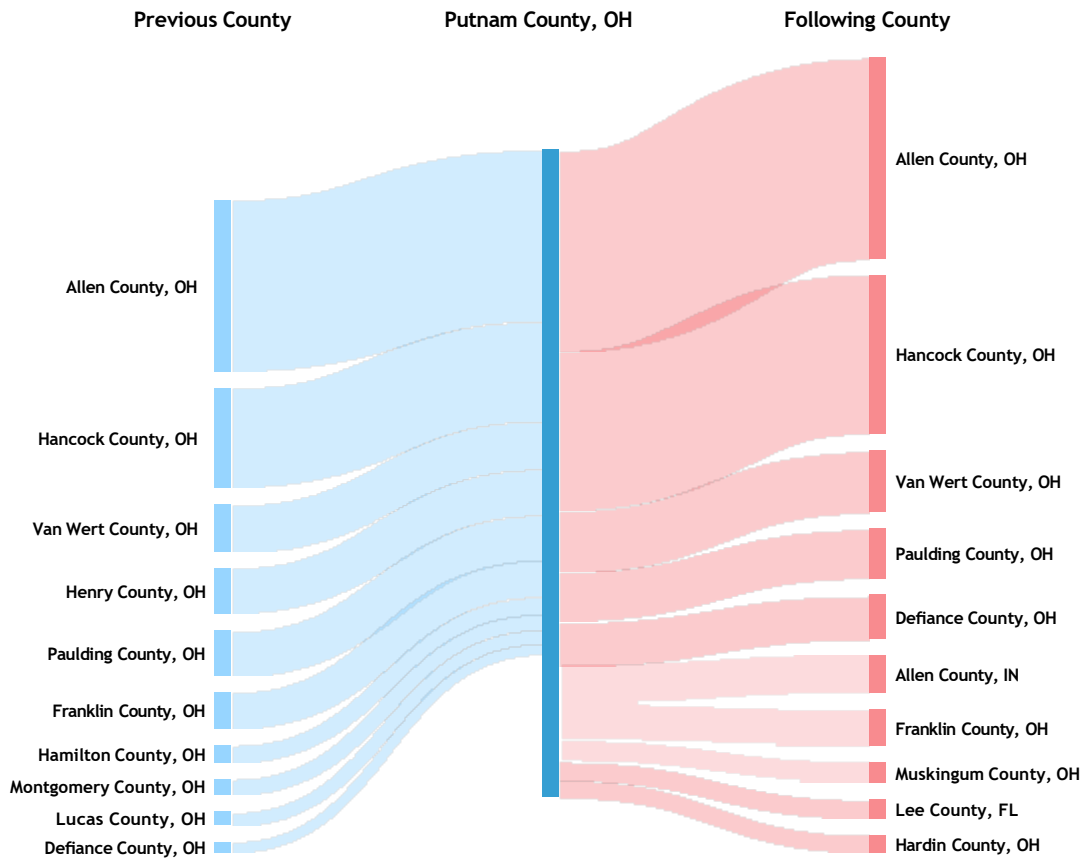

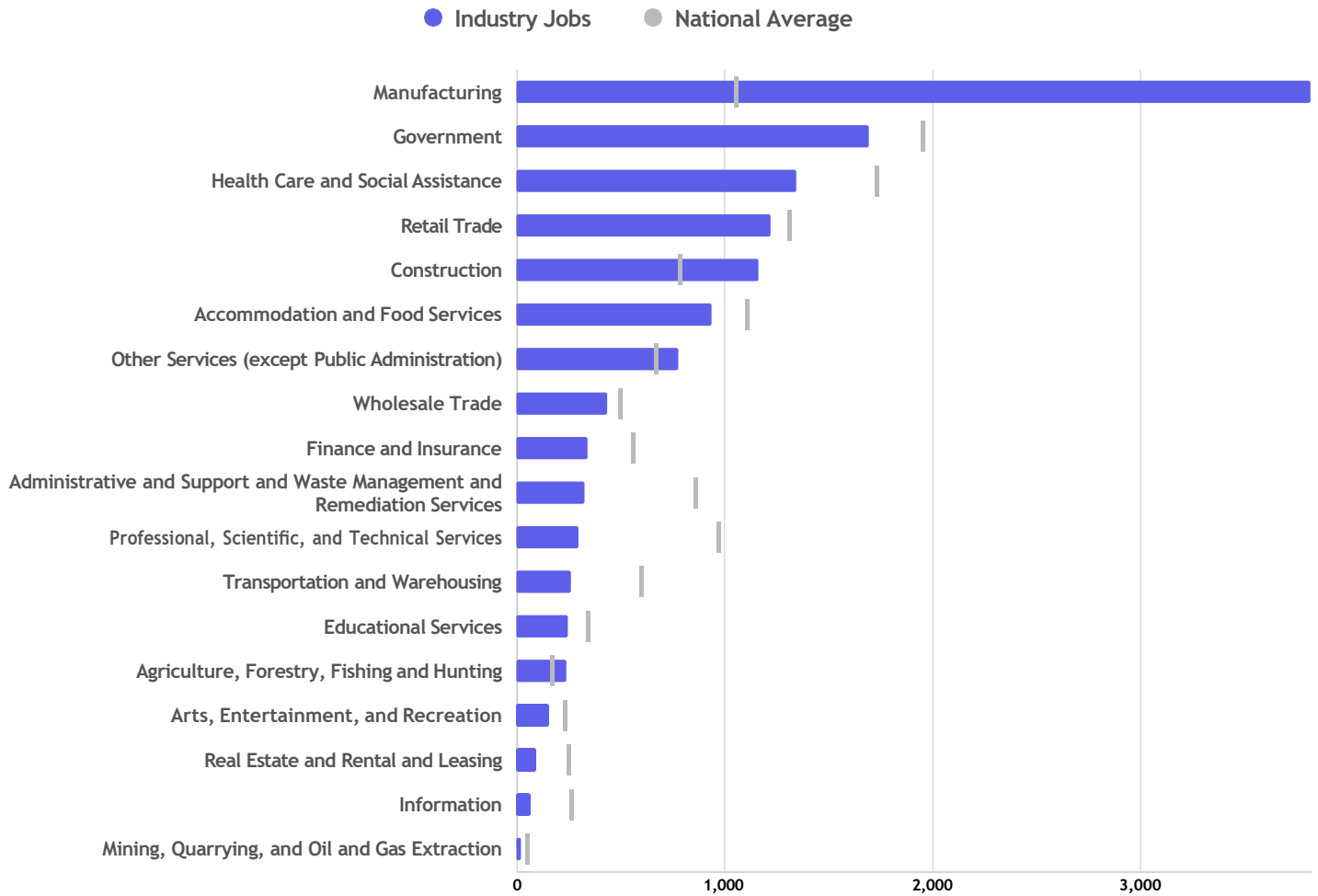

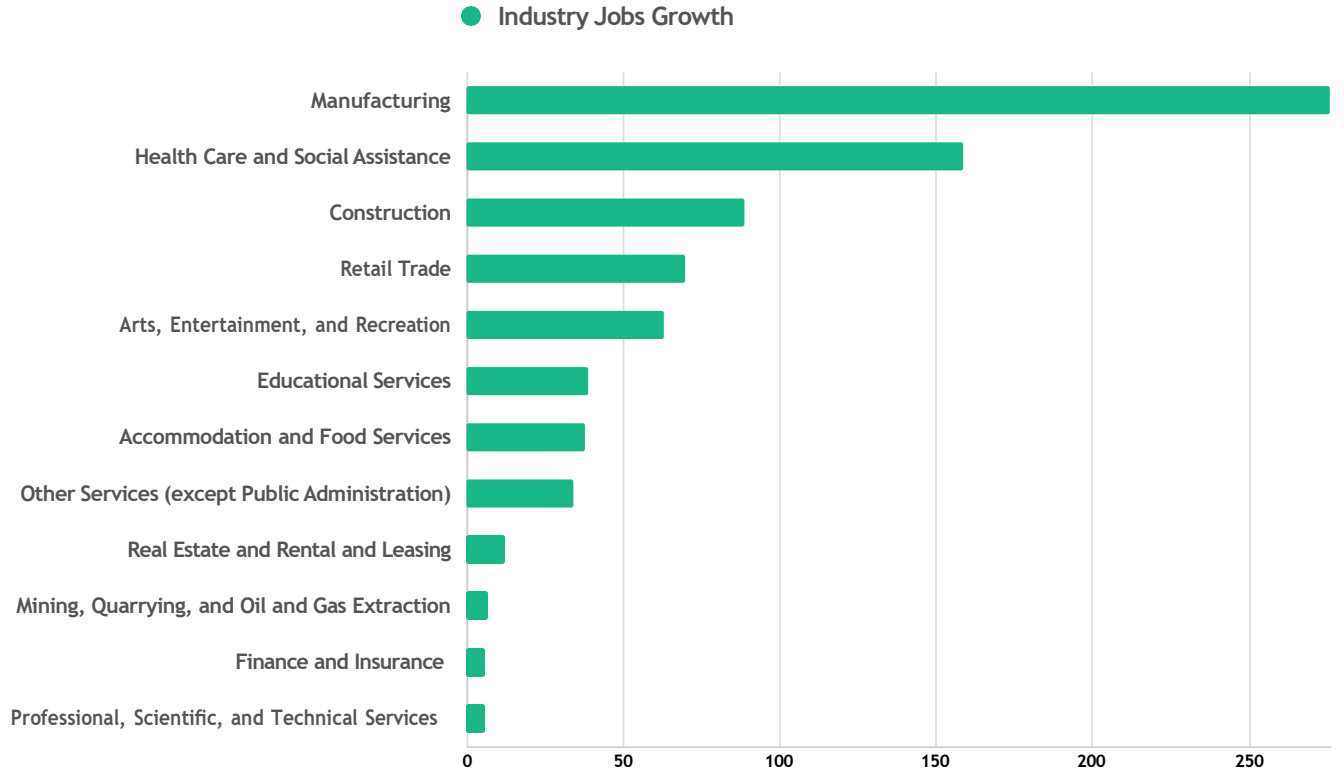

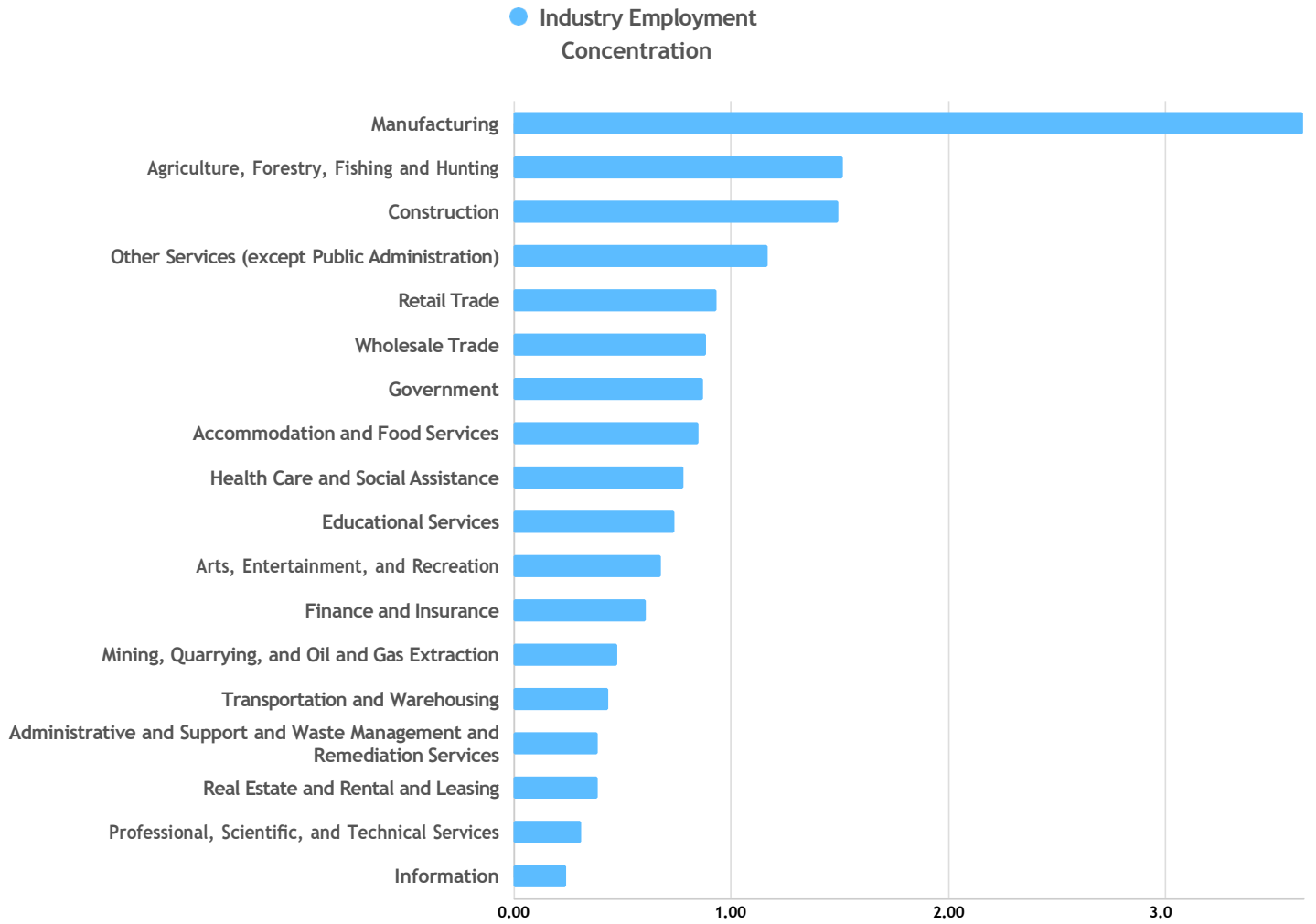


Top Growing Industries



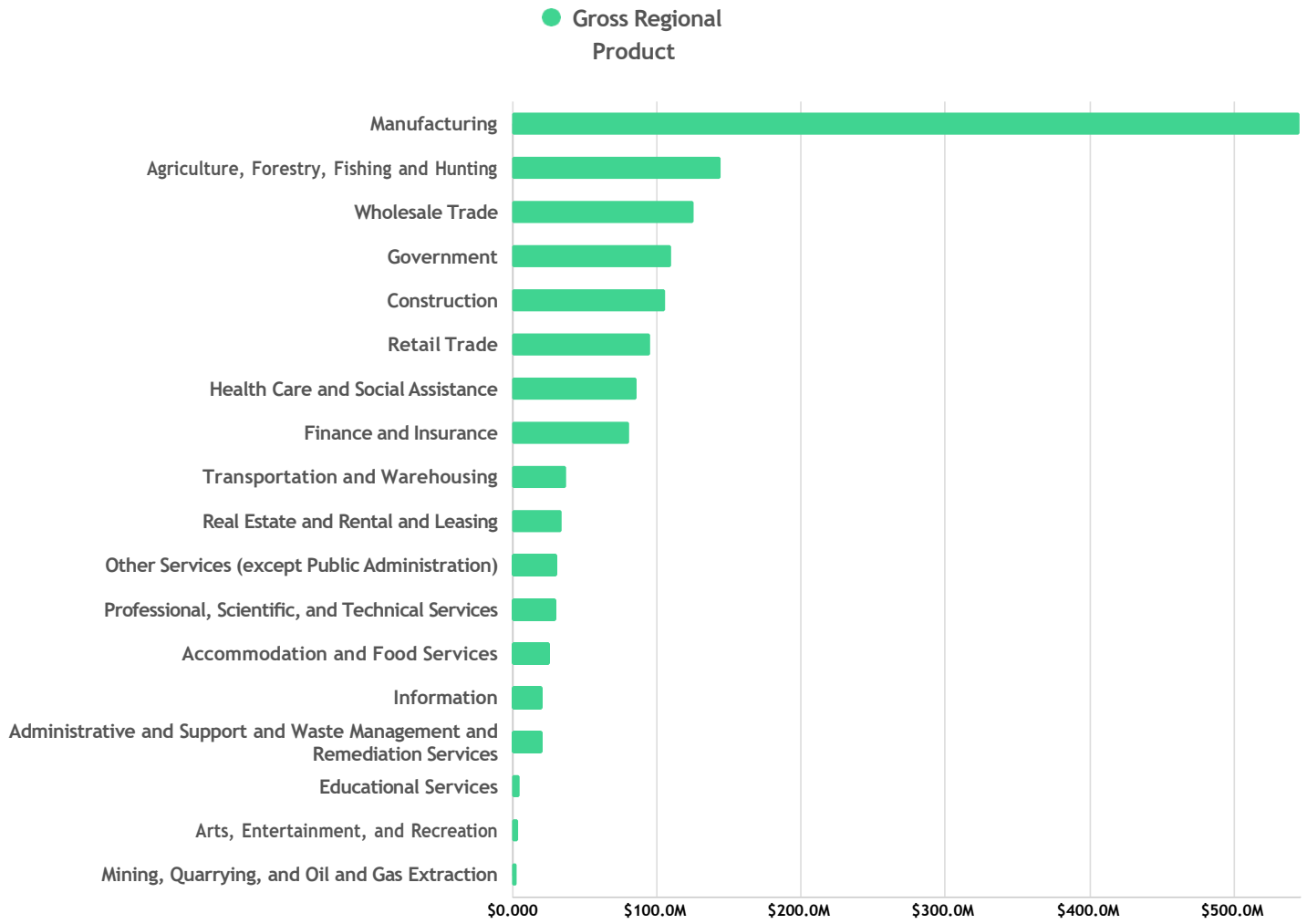


Top Industry Employment Concentration



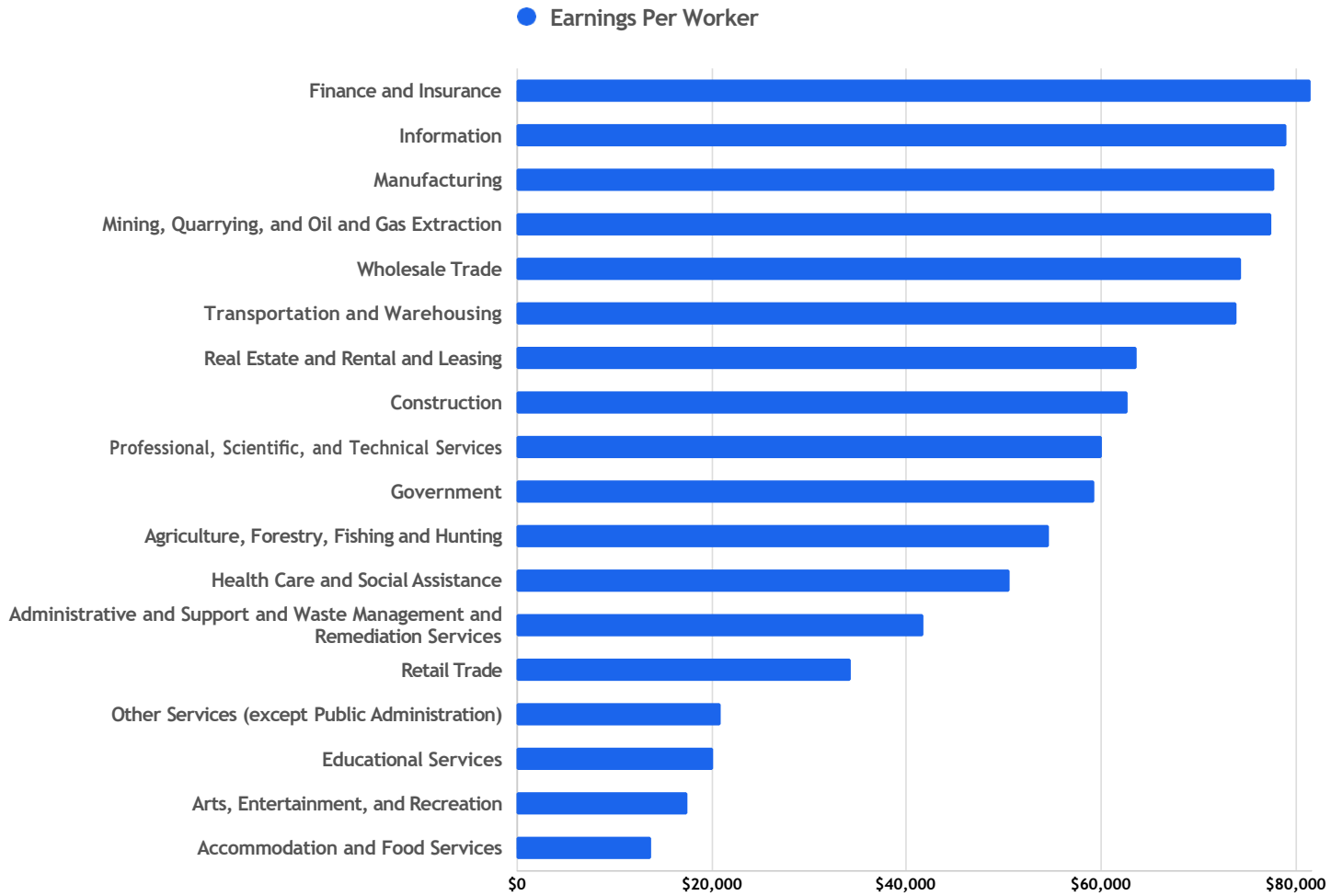


Top Industry GRP

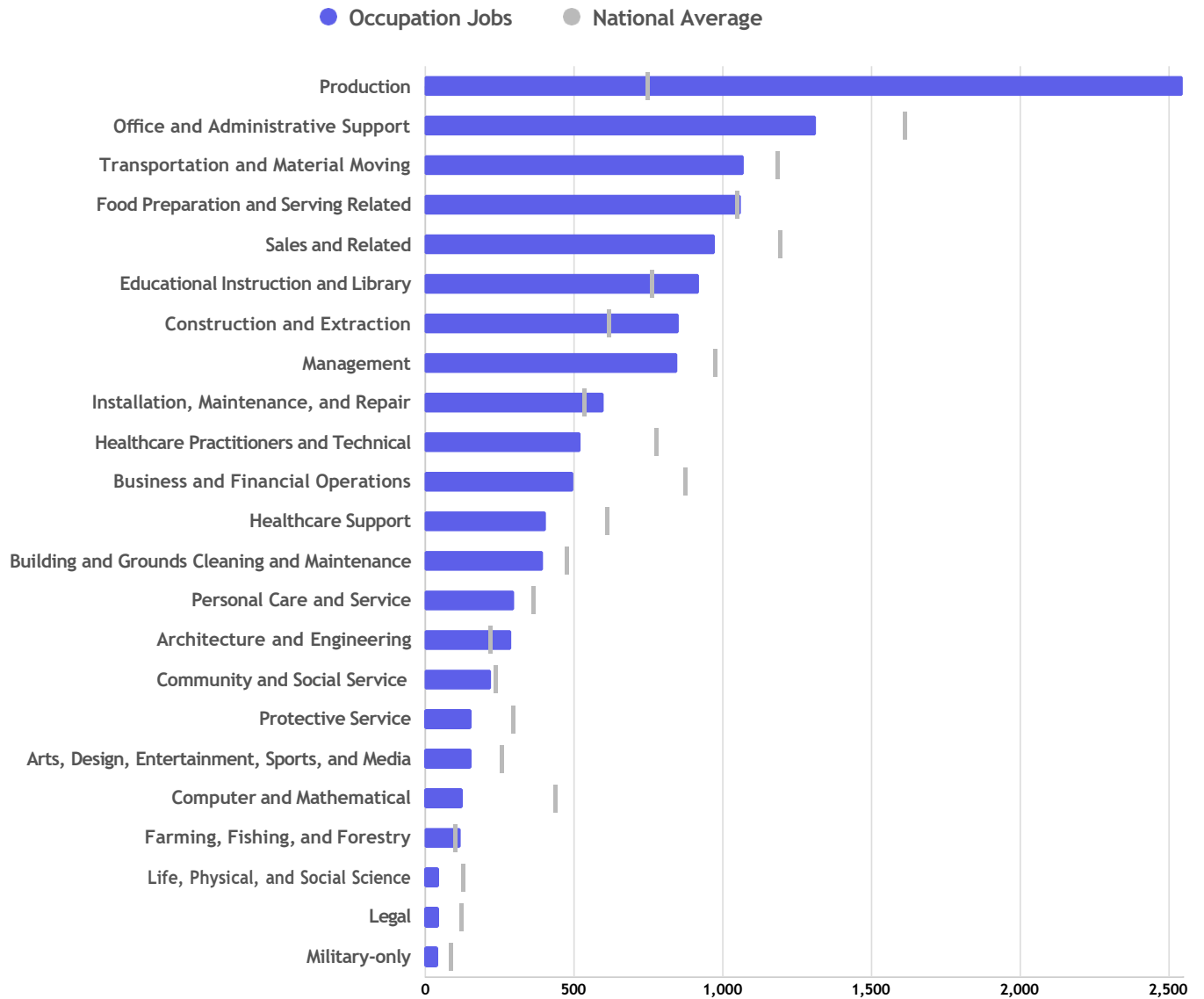

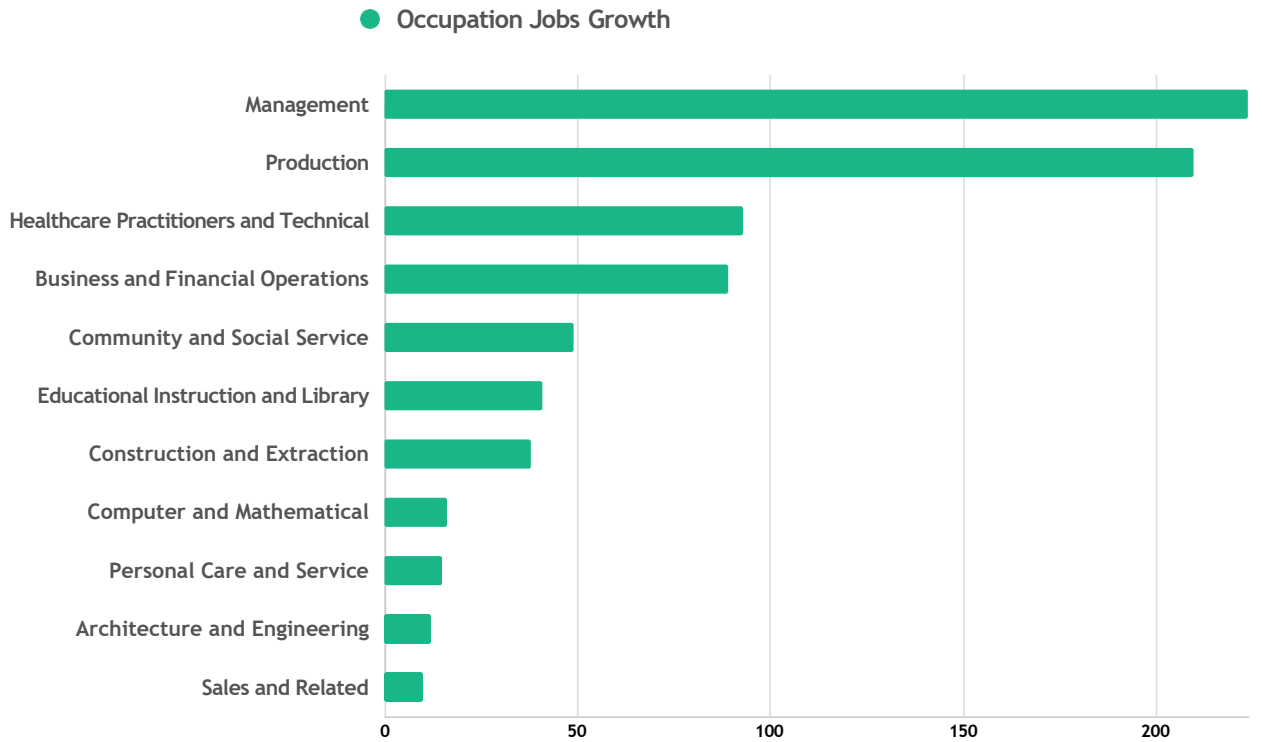

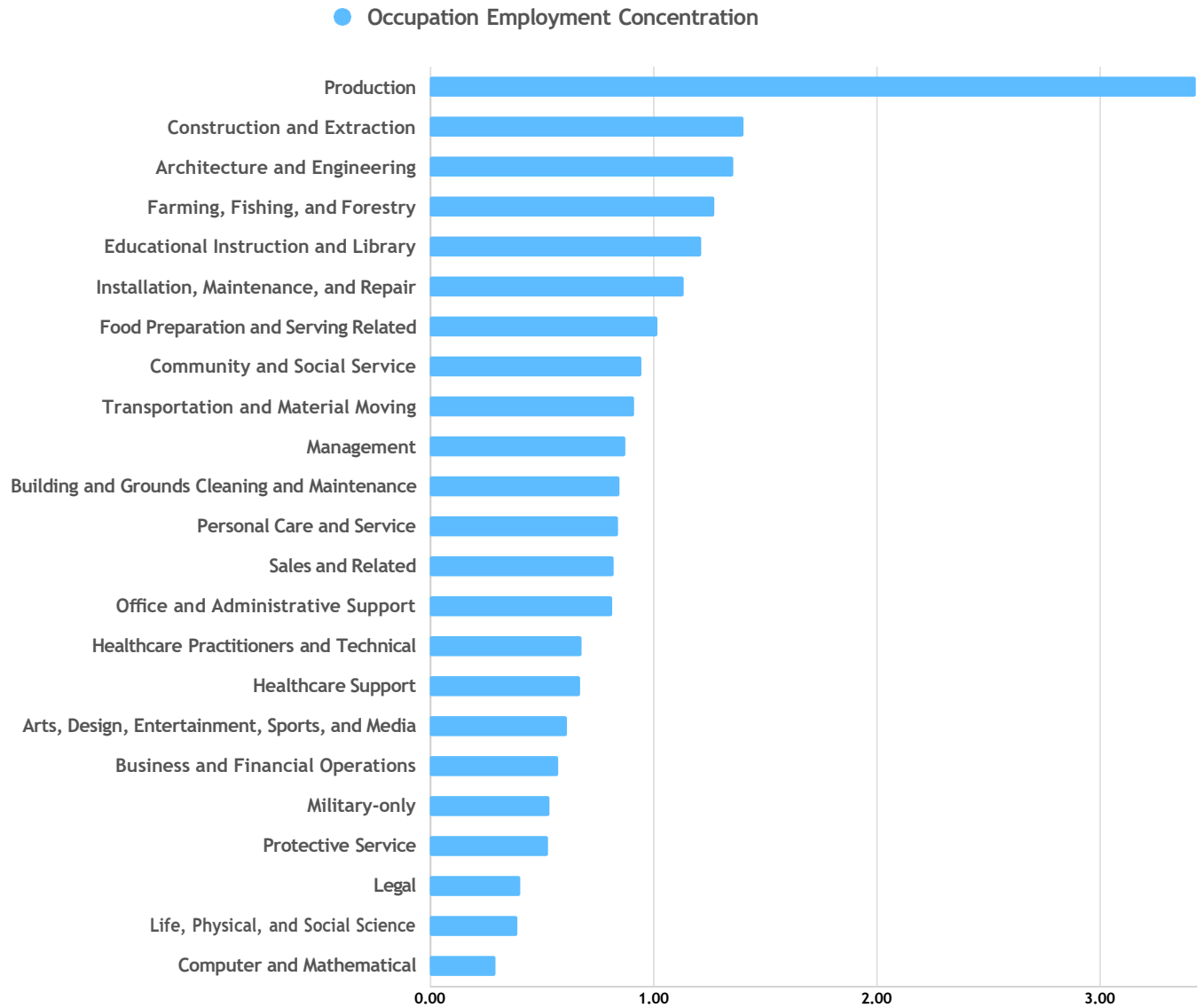


Top Growing Occupations



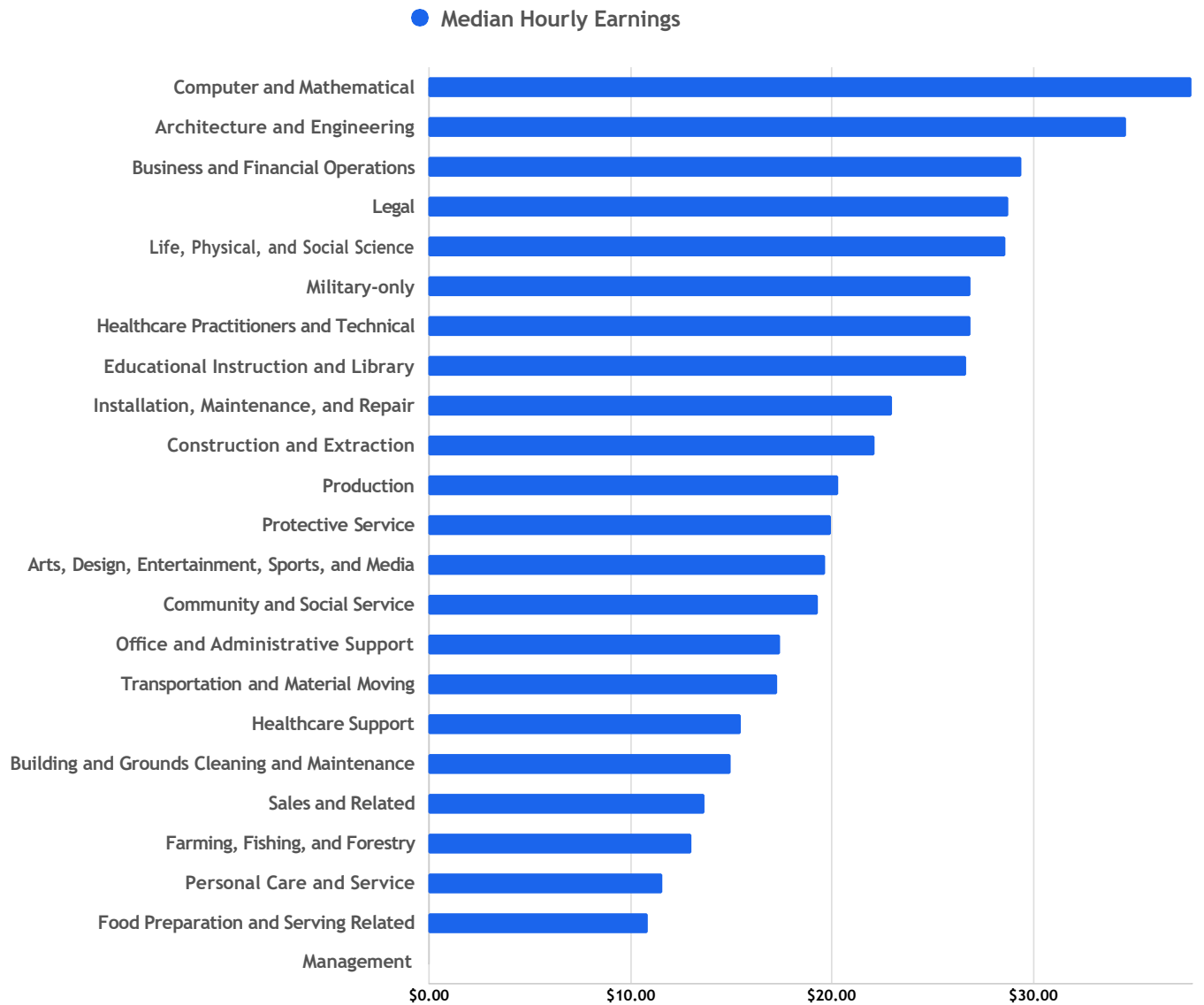


Top Occupation Employment Concentration



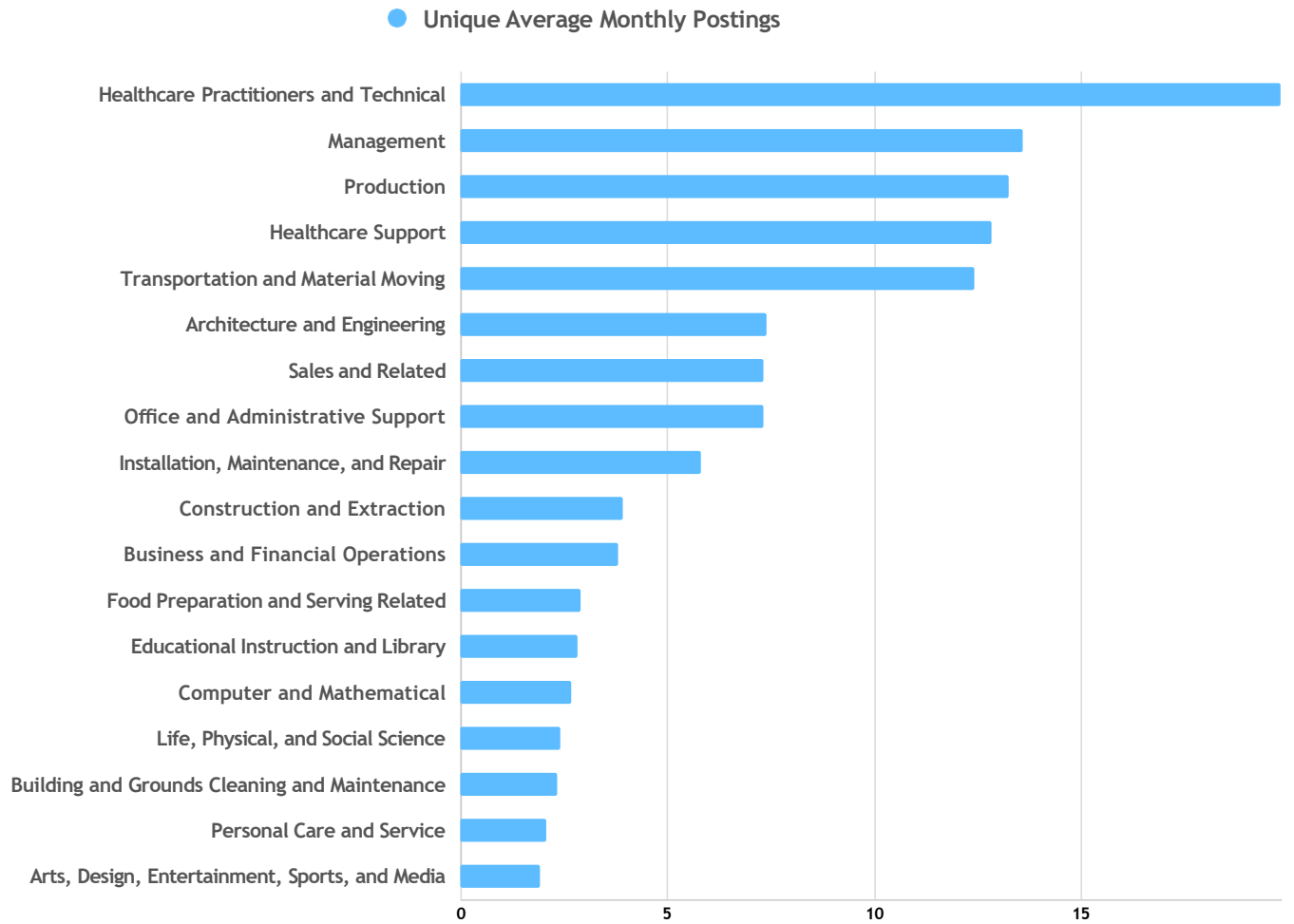


Top Occupation Earnings



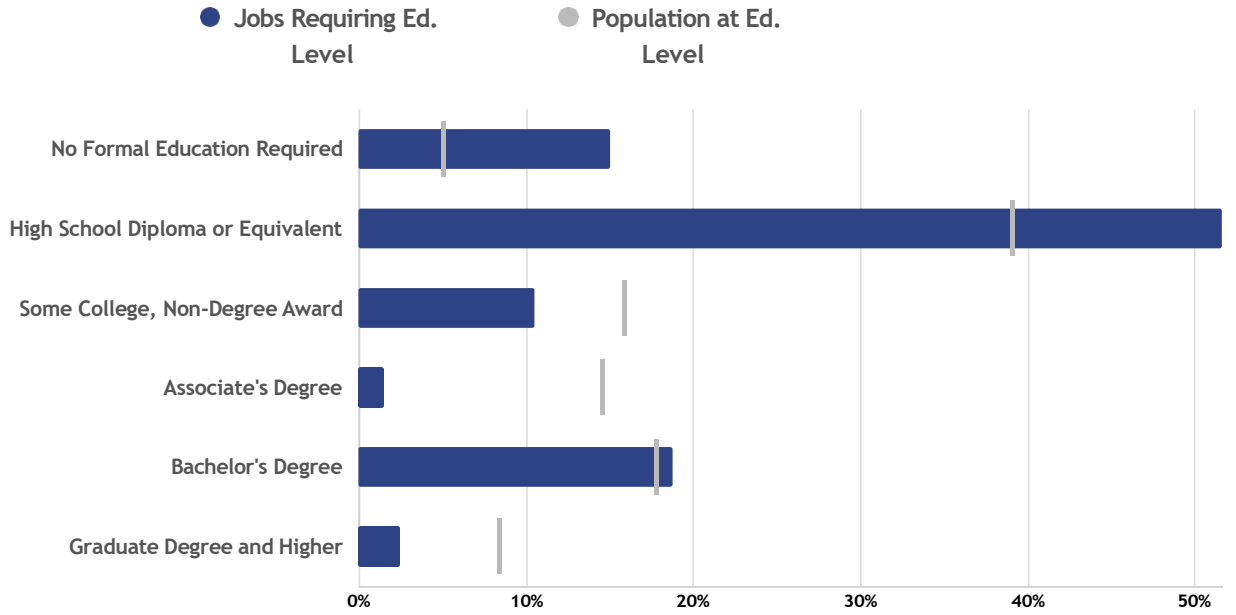
